How it works

- 1. Set date and time
- **2.** Choose a tasting from the menu or discuss a bespoke theme with us
- **3.** Confirm numbers
- **4.** Pay for the event via www.thestory.com.au or invoice your choice
- **5.** Dispatch/deliver wine to each household see the nitty gritty
- **6.** Pre-event chat about the audience/theme/ mood and any final details
- **7.** Jump on Zoom and taste together
